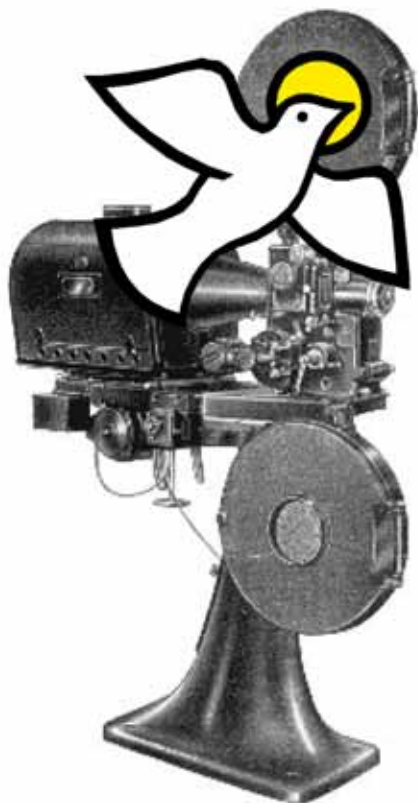

Filmed in Afghanistan and Laos, Footprints is a study of the effect of cluster bombs on people and landscape. Where once a landscape was life-providing, after contamination by these bombs, it becomes a source of terror and death. The film studies the landscape and its people, and enquires into the lives and dreams of the victims of cluster-bomb accidents.
